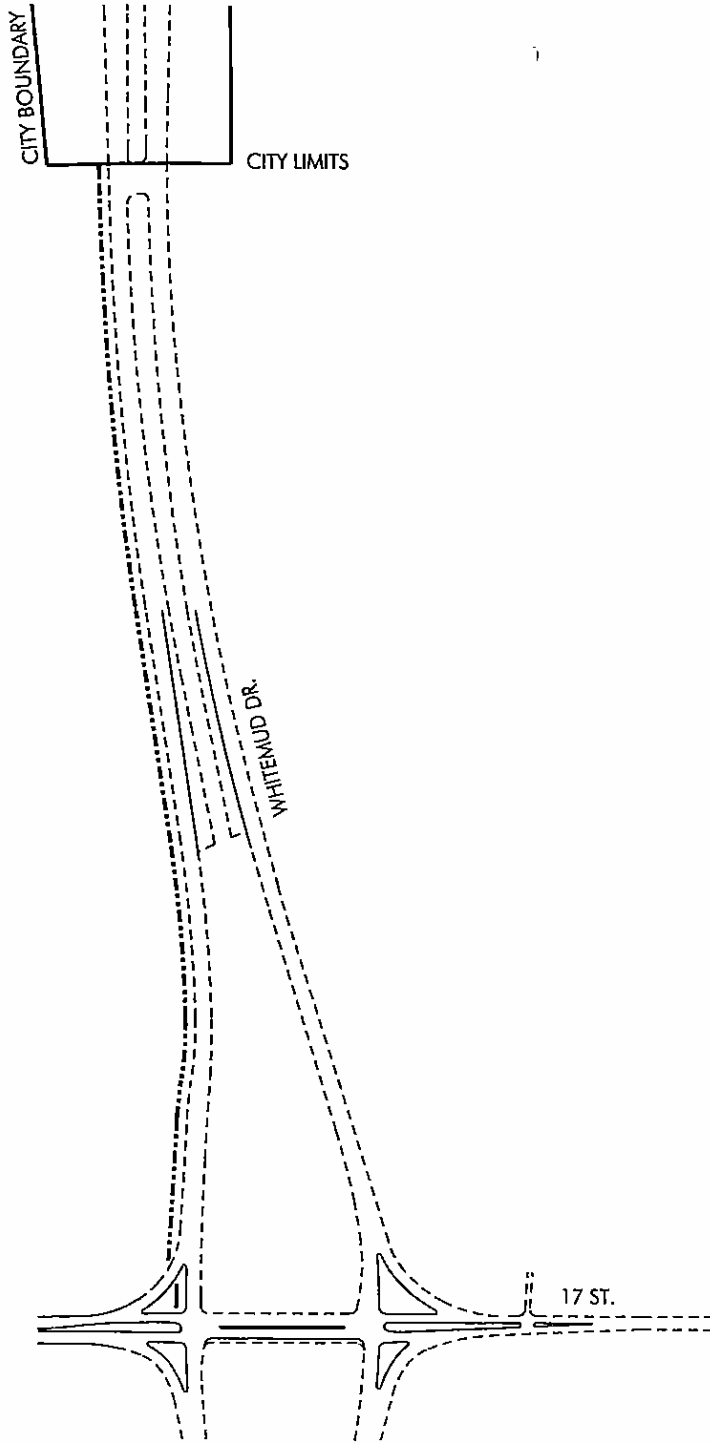


**Schedule "A"**  
"Adopted Roadway"



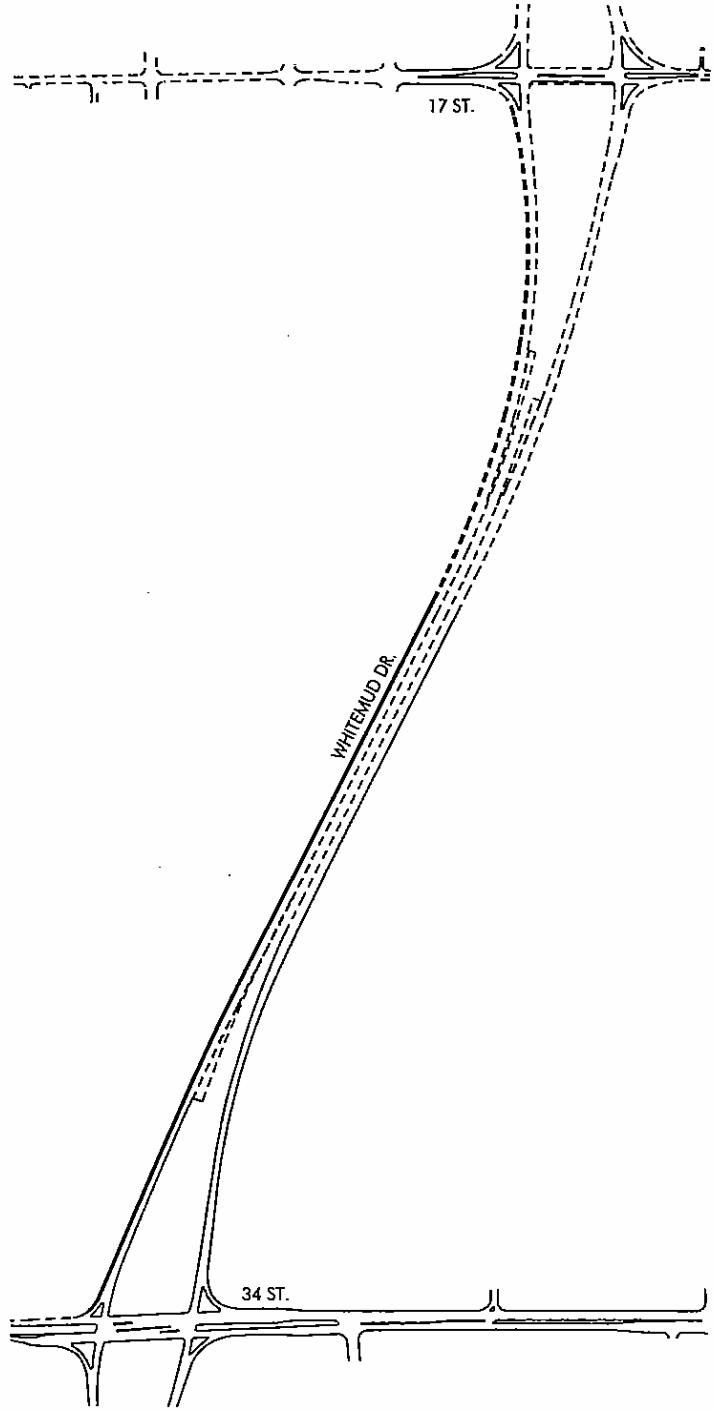
Location 49

## **KEEPING EDMONTON CLEAN – GUIDELINES (Schedule “B” – 2 Pages)**

- 1) The Adopt a Roadway Agreement will expire December 31, 2005. Thereafter, Applicants that continue in the program will be required to continue with their adoption for an additional minimum period of 3 years.
- 2) The Applicant will ensure that litter is picked up at least twice a year, once in the spring and prior to winter.
- 3) The Applicant or a designated adult for the Applicant (the “Group Leader”) will be required to sign the Keeping Edmonton Clean – Adopt a Road Agreement and either the Applicant or the Group Leader must attend the City of Edmonton Adopt a Road Safety Talk Training Course
- 4) The City of Edmonton, Adopt a Road Safety Talk Training Course will be open to anyone who is or wants to pick up litter for an Applicant. The Applicants or the designated Group Leader must conduct a safety talk in accordance with the Adopt a Road Safety Talk Training Course prior to each litter pick-up at which all volunteers for that litter pick up event must attend.
- 5) The City of Edmonton will provide WCB volunteer coverage
- 6) Litter pick-up will take place during daylight hours (one hour after sunrise and one hour before sunset). Litter pick-up will not be undertaken during rainy, foggy weather or when the road is wet or icy.
- 7) If the Applicant is to use volunteers all volunteers must be at least 10 years of age and all volunteers under the age of 16 years old must have their parent’s or guardian’s permission to participate in the Adopt a Roadway program. Volunteers under the age of 14 require mandatory supervision of 1 adult to 2 volunteers. Volunteers aged 14-18 years old require mandatory supervision of 1 adult to 4 volunteers.
- 8) The City of Edmonton recommends a minimum of 3 people per kilometre adopted to conduct the litter pick up.
- 9) No pets are allowed in the work area during litter pick-up.
- 10) Vehicles may not be parked on the roadway surface. Car pooling to worksite is recommended.
- 11) The City of Edmonton will supply safety vests, safety signs, litterbags and recognition signs. Department personnel will install the recognition signs.
- 12) Safety supplies furnished by the City of Edmonton must be picked up during regular working hours 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., weekdays only.
- 13) Anyone picking up litter for the Applicant must wear a safety vest during clean-up activities.
- 14) The Applicant or the adult Group Leader for the Applicant will advise the City of Edmonton representative 3 days in advance as to pickup date in order that department forces can schedule to pick up and dispose of litter bags.

- 15) Filled litterbags will be placed along the shoulders of the roadways and will be disposed of by City of Edmonton personnel. All bags are to be tied shut after filling. The Applicant or the adult Group Leader will notify the City of Edmonton at the completion of each pick up by completing a Summary Report.
- 16) Adoption includes only the right side of roadway unless otherwise specified by the City of Edmonton representative.
- 17) All accidents/incidents during the course of the litter pickup shall be reported to the City of Edmonton representative within 24 hours of occurrence.
- 18) Anyone picking up litter for the Applicant will not direct, stop or interfere with traffic.
- 19) Use of controlled substances by anyone picking up litter for the Applicant is prohibited during clean up activities.
- 20) Anyone picking up litter for the Applicant shall not trespass or interfere with the rights of private landowners.
- 21) The Applicant is encouraged to separate and recycle material for the Applicant's benefit.
- 22) Adoption can be terminated by the City of Edmonton if, in the sole discretion of the City, the City determines that the Applicant fails to:
  - a) comply with the Applicant's obligations under the Agreement;
  - b) comply with any of these guidelines or any such additional or other guidelines that the City may issue from time to time;
  - c) perform or have the litter pick up performed in a manner considered safe by the City;
  - d) Provide adequate and effective litter pickup.
- 23) Without limiting the generality of paragraph 22 of these Guidelines, the City may at anytime terminate the Agreement without cause.
